## CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted Sparklers or fountains that are: nonexplosive and

non-aerial, contain no more than 100 grams of pyrotechnic mixture per item, do not contain magnesium (except magnalium or magnesiumaluminum alloy), contain no more than 5 grams of chlorate or perchlorate salts per item, and "when more than one fountain is mounted on a common base, the total pyrotechnic composition does not

exceed two hundred grams."

Specifically prohibited All other consumer fireworks

Age of purchase 16 years

## **DISPLAY FIREWORKS**

Display permit Apply to local fire marshal prior to application to

> State Fire Marshal. Apply to the entity proscribed by the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection at least 15 days before display

date. Fee of \$100.

property damage.

Operator State license and certificate of competency

required. Fee of \$200 is paid to state treasurer. May be renewed every three years with a fee of \$100. Assistants must be at least 18 years of age.
