CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted "[W]ire or wood sparklers of not more than 100 grams of

mixture per item, other sparkling items which are

nonexplosive and nonaerial and contain 75 grams or less of chemical mixture per tube or a total of 500 grams or less for multiple tubes, snakes and glow worms, smoke devices, or trick noisemakers which include paper streamers, party poppers, string poppers, snappers, and drop pops, each consisting of not more than twenty-five hundredths grains of

explosive mixture."

Specifically prohibited Firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, , Roman candles,

daygo bombs, and sparklers (other than those permitted as

noted above).

Age to purchase 18 years

DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display permit For outdoor displays, apply to municipal clerk where the

display will take place or county auditor if display will take place outside a city at least 15 days before date of display. For indoor displays, apply to the state fire marshal at least 15 days before the date of the display. Indoor permit fee is

\$150.

Insurance Required, in amount deemed adequate by fire chief.

Operator Must be state certified. Must be 21 years of age, pass a

written exam, and provide proof of experience. Fee: \$100.

LICENSING Local authorities may impose an annual license fee on

retailers.
